Day 5 - April 10th: San Francisco to Solvang, CA (B)

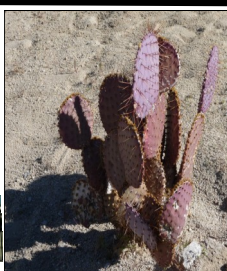
- * You will arrive early enough today into the Danish town of Solvang. Browse the many shops and maybe try some of the pastries in the Danish Bakery.

- * You will marvel at the lights of Las Vegas strip before taking in the dazzling laser show on Fremont Street.

Day 11 - April 16th: Las Vegas, Nevada
