



Spring Warm Up Coach and Cruise

April 22 - May 12, 2012 - 21 Days

Day 7 - April 28th: Palm Springs (B)

Today you have an optional trip to an outdoor market hosted at the College of the Desert. This is a favorite amongst the locals for unique finds and great bargains. This afternoon you can relax by the pool or browse the shops of Palm Canyon Drive. Enjoy the entertainment of the fabulous Palm Springs Follies - a world-famous, Broadway caliber celebration of the music, dance, and comedy of the 40s, 50s, and 60s.

Day 12 - May 3rd: Tucson, AZ (B)
