



Gems of the Pacific Northwest

Jun 3-5th, 2012 - 3 Days

Join Bob and Teresa as you explore and discover some of the gems of the Pacific Northwest. Ever wondered how they make those Boeing Airplanes? In Eatonville's Northwest Trek, watch the wild life in the comfort of a naturalist-guided tram winds through 435 acres of meadows, woods, and lakes filled with native wildlife. Tacoma's Museum of Glass is another gem that won't disappoint as you admire this impressive form of art and see it being created from the molten glass.



Day 1: June 3 - to Tacoma

- Door to door pick up with a stop at the Duty Free Store before crossing into the U.S.
- You will have a choice to have lunch and do some factory outlet shopping in Marysville or try your luck at the Tulalip Casino.
- Tour the world's largest building at the Boeing's Everett factory and the Future of flight Aviation center. You will see airplane being built for some of their worldwide base of airline customers.
- You have several great choices for dinner within walking distance to your hotel in Tacoma.

Day 2: June 4 - Tacoma (B)

- Experience captivating Northwest wildlife. Whether you are peering out of the tram at bellowing bison less than 10 feet away or standing nose-to-nose with an otter, exciting wildlife encounters happen every day at Northwest Trek.
- You will have a richer understanding as you learn all about the art of glass at a docent led interactive tour in the Museum of Glass in Tacoma. Witness art coming alive at the Museum's Hot Shop Team demonstrate the fascinating process of creating works of art from molten glass.
- Be sure to walk over the Chihuly Bridge of Glass, a 500 ft long pedestrian overpass.

Day 3: June 5 - Tacoma to Home (B)

- Travel North on the East side of the Olympic Peninsula with a stop at the Scandinavian themed town of Poulsbo on Liberty Bay with many shops to browse.
- Explore and enjoy your lunch stop in Port Townsend, known for its many Victorian buildings still standing from its late 19th century heyday.
- Cross over the Puget Sound by ferry to Widby Island and North to the Canadian Border.
- Duty Free Stop and door to door home return.
