



# Northern Peace Country of BC and Alberta

## June 16-24th, 2012 - 9 Days

If you have ever wanted to explore more of the country you live in, this is the tour to do it. The northern peace country is filled with jagged mountain peaks, roaring rivers, serene lakes and green valleys. The wild life consists of bear, elk, moose, deer, wolves and many more. Travel on the Alaska Highway, the Yellowhead Highway and tour the largest earth filled structure, WAC Bennett Dam. Other highlights include; Hell's Gate, Slave Lake, West Edmonton Mall, Jasper, Mt Robson & Maligne Canyon.



### Day 1: June 16 -to 100 Mile house (L/D)

- Door to door pick up.
- Traverse down the Fraser Canyon in a breathtaking aerial tramway and enjoy a group lunch at Hell's Gate.
- Continue North through the historic Fraser Canyon with a stop at Chasm Provincial Park to see the spectacular display of color illustrating the parks rich geology.
- Get to know your travel friends at a special group welcome dinner tonight.

### Day 2: June 17-100 Mile House to Prince George

- Arriving in Prince George early today, you have some time to explore the Railway and Forestry Museum. Climb aboard vintage rail coaches from the 1900's.
- You may want to try your luck at your Casino Hotel this evening.

### Day 3: June 18 - Prince George to Dawson Creek (B/L)

- Detour off Hwy 97 to discover the mill town of the recently rejuvenated MacKenzie.
- Enjoy a group lunch at MacKenzie Junction.
- A picture of the "Mile 0" Cairn is a must see at the start of the Alaska Highway. Here you will also have some time at the Northern Alberta Railway Park and visitor center.

### Day 4: June 19 - Dawson Creek (B/L)

- A great day trip today to the WAC Bennett Dam where you will have a private tour into the impressive powerhouse.
- Enjoy your group lunch overlooking Williston Lake.

### Day 5: June 20 - Dawson Creek to Slave Lake, Alberta (B)

- Enter the Peace Country through the city of Grand Prairie viewing the amazing natural surroundings and hopefully abundant wild life it is famous for.
- This area you travel through today are the natural habitat for elk, moose, deer, wolf and bear.
- Slave Lake is surrounded by lush forests and numerous lakes. Enjoy this small community located on the eastern end of Lesser Slave Lake.

### Day 6: July 21—Slave lake to Edmonton (B)

- Head South today through agriculture country of Westlock and then into Canada's Northern most city, Edmonton, Alberta's Capital.
- Discover the biggest attraction and the world's largest shopping center, West Edmonton Mall. No sales tax in Alberta!

### Day 7: June 22- Edmonton to Jasper (B)

- On the Yellowhead Highway travel west into Jasper National Park, part of a spectacular World Heritage Site.
- After lunch on your own in Jasper you can explore one of the site destinations, the Maligne Canyon, a 50 ft high canyon in a deep river gorge surrounded by eroded cliffs, water falls and plant life.
- You return to Jasper in time to browse the shops and discover more of this Park town.

### Day 8: June 23 - Jasper to Kamloops (B)

- The icefield parkway is considered a world class journey through the heart of the Canadian Rockies. Travel along for an unforgettable visit to two falls, the Sumwapta and Athabasca Falls.
- Lunch on your own today at the base of the highest peak in the Cdn Rockies, Mt. Robson.
- Tonight you may want to try your luck at the local Casino downtown.

### Day 9: June 24 - Kamloops to home (B)

- Instead of the Coquihalla Hwy, you travel the more scenic Hwy 5A with a stop at the historic Quilchena Hotel.
- A group lunch at another historic hotel in Merritt and time to tour their murals and walk of the stars.
- Door to door return.
