DAY 1: JULY 24 - TO WHISTLER, BC

- Door to door pick up.
- Wind north from Vancouver with a stop at the 335 meter high Shannon Falls.
- Intensely scenic, you drive to Whistler on the Sea to Sky Highway.
- Re-live the memorable moments of the 2010 Olympic and Para Olympic games as you tour through some of the venues remaining and actively used in Whistler.

DAY 2: JULY 25-WHISTLER TO SUN PEAKS B/L

- Travel north on Hwy 99 through Caribou Country. Guaranteed to see wild life today, anything from bears to mountain goats.
- Enjoy a great lunch at Cache Creek nestled between the Canadian Rockies and Purcell Mountain Ranges.
- Travel through ranch country and up to Sun Peaks. Admire the summer mountain wild flowers coming into bloom on the mountain sides. Stroll through the shops in the Village.

DAY 3: JULY 26 - SUN PEAKS TO KELOWNA (B)

- Depart this morning in the brisk mountain air and travel to your next ski mountain outside of Vernon, Silver Star.
- From the mountains to the Okanagan fruit belt you visit "The Jammery". See how they take the local fruits and berries and create wonderful jams and preserves. Yummy samples.
- You can't be in the Okanagan and not visit one of the world class wineries. Summerhill Pyramid Winery overlooks Okanagan Lake and follows the very strict organic growing practices. Their wines are regularly honored in international competitions.
- Stroll along the lakes shore on this summer evening close to your downtown accommodations in Kelowna.

Day 4: July 27 - Kelowna to Osoyoos (B)

- Big White is a winter wonderland for skiers and snow enthusiasts. Only 55 km from Kelowna. Enjoy the vast slopes of the summer wild flowers as you head towards Osoyoos.
- Tickleberries in Okanagan Falls is famous for their ice cream so yes, we have to stop and try some.
- Model railway enthusiast or not, you will marvel at the Osoyoos Desert Model Railway Museum, a World Class miniature fantasy world.
- Check into your accommodations on the shores of Osoyoos Lake and enjoy a refreshing dip in the Lake.

Day 5: July 28 - Osoyoos to Home (B/L)

- Keremeos is the fruit stand belt of the Okanagan. Bring some home if you wish as we make a stop.
- Your last mountains are in breathtaking Manning Park. Enjoy a group lunch and then travel around the Park and absorb it's natural beauty.
- Door to door home return.
